

Mission

The Montgomery County Christmas Store (MCCS) is a non-denominational, all-volunteer, community-wide, non-profit organization that assists eligible low-income individuals and families in Montgomery County during the Christmas season by providing a shopping experience characterized by choice and dignity.

The Store is open for eligible shoppers for one week annually in December.

Eligibility

To shop at the Christmas Store, you must:

1. Have an income not greater than 125% of the federal poverty guidelines.
2. Be a resident of Montgomery County, AND,
3. Meet one or more of the following criteria:
 - Have school-aged children in the home
 - Have adults 62 years of age or older in the home
 - Receive some type of disability income

Shoppers may select new clothing, consumable goods, new toys, books, and food.
